Subject and Objective	The objective is to enhance the quality of life of older people and strengthen the industrial base in Europe through the use of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT). It aims to address social isolation and reducing loneliness by bridging distances, facilitating interaction and communication, thus enabling people to live in their preferred environment as long as possible. This call addresses social interaction with a focus on the cognitive, psychosocial and cultural aspects.
Subject Call 3	ICT-based Solutions for Advancement of Older Persons’ Independence and Participation in the “Self-Serve Society” Relevant application areas are - Home environment and related activities of daily living – at home, on holiday, in visits (“mobile enabled solutions”) - Transportation and travel activities
Duration	12-36 months Time to market : 2-3 years after the end of the project
